REPAIRING BALL MARKS:

The Proper Technique for Ball Mark Repair

Insert the ball mark repair tool behind the ball mark and gently pull the top of the tool toward the center. Continue working around the ball mark, pulling the surrounding turf in toward the center. Avoid using a lifting or twisting motion because this can damage turf roots. Once you have finished, gently tamp the area down with your putter to create a smooth, firm surface.

Unrepaired ball marks cause lasting problems

Unrepaired ball marks can take weeks to heal and can cause balls to bounce off-line. **If our Members contribute to ball mark repair we could, significantly, improve our greens.**

MEET NICK CHRISTOU, JR., Owner of Mitchell's Tavern and Club Sponsor

A wise man said: "It's all about family."

Nick Christou, Sr., at 16 years of age migrated from his native Greece to Windsor, Ontario in the 1950's. On the heels of WWII and with Europe in turmoil, the eldest son of 7 children, Mr. Christou sought a better life in North America and arrived in Canada with little more than his love of cooking and a dream. He found sanctuary in the Greek community there and, having had no formal education, he lived a simple life that revolved chiefly around his job in local restaurants. With the money he sent to Greece he helped the majority of his family to come to America for a better life. A matchmaker introduced Nick to a young lady named Daphne and days later they were engaged to be married. With another relative the newlyweds started Nick and John's, a restaurant on Abbott Road in Lackawanna where Nick learned the art of restauranting by providing quality food and a family friendly dining experience. Quickly, his restaurant became one of the area's favorite dining spots.

In 1988, Mr. & Mrs. Christou purchased Mitchell's Tavern on Sheridan Dr. from Daphne's uncle, Peter Triantafillou who, in 1974 had opened the small business originally owned by the Mitchell family. Thus, the Christou family has owned and operated the current facility for nearly 50 years. The legendary Hamilton's Restaurant was owned by Nick Jr.'s grandparents, Jimmy "the Greek" and Melody who were regular golfers at Sheridan well into their 80's. The Christou and Triantafillou families shared a love of golf with both Peter and Nick, Sr. being past champions at Sheridan. Hamilton's, which abutted the Sheridan Course was, for many years, a haven for early morning golfers awaiting their starting times.

I had the pleasure of meeting with Mitchell's current proprietor, Nick Jr. who shared much of the family history and the rich legacy of a hard-working family whose mantra has always been to work harder than the other guy, be willing to make changes, provide a quality product and treat your patrons with the respect they deserve. He reminisced about the changing restaurant dynamic citing the number of restaurants that have closed in the years he has been in business.

Nick has run the business since 2000 and, while his Dad and he spent countless days and hours working together, Nick Jr. has held the reins for these 20 years. As we spoke, Nick paid tribute to his mom and dad for their work ethics and undying commitment to the hospitality industry. His Dad, a Sheridan Club Champion, passed away March 2020 and Nick still mourns the loss as he reflects on the footprint his father provided and the quality of life that he afforded Nick, his mom and his sisters.

An accomplished athlete who starred at Sweet Home and Canisius College in soccer, Nick has festooned the tavern with sports memorabilia and is proud of the fact that he and his staff were able to remain open through the darkest days of the pandemic. He indicated that his regular customer base has remained steady and that, he has added catering to his business model along with a meeting facility in the basement and his outdoor patio. Numbers of new patrons, including this writer, have found the food, ambiance, beverages and staff very much to our liking.

Nick has played soccer at its highest level in this area, played professional indoor soccer out of state, has coached local high school and college teams and has run a school for aspiring goalkeepers. These days, Nick who resides in Grand Island with his wife, Marlene and their "two amazing daughters" Sofia age 5 and Alena age 3 maintains a hectic yet fulfilling schedule. As we concluded our chat I had to ask if Nick is responsible for all the hiring. Smiling, he nodded an evident "yes" and should you need to know the nature of that smile, all you need do is meet any of his amazing staff. Sheridan is most fortunate to have Mitchell's as a sponsor and as a nearby watering hole perfect for an après golf experience.

And, yes, that wise man who spoke so dearly of family was Nick's dad, the late Nick Christou, Sr.
