#### LOCAL RULES UPDATE (6/9/22)

- We will be playing the ball down this year. (Exception: any ball or stance in the winter kill spots in the fairway only will be lift, clean and place). No relief in the rough.
- Hole #6 bunker is ground under repair. Relief is closest point from the ball to outside the bunker not nearer to the hole.
- Hole # 14, player, with the assistance of the group determines the ball crossed the hazard and hit land and then lands in the penalty area. Player must now identify his ball and proceed under the rules of penalty areas. If the player cannot identify his ball, then they must proceed to the drop area.

#### SHERIDAN AT DANDE FARMS - CLUB CLASH EVENT (AUGUST 20, 2022)

- > Qualifying will begin approximately one month prior to the evens, the sheet will be put up in the locker room.
- Each member can only play 1 Qualifying Round. Post your GROSS SCORE on the Qualifier Sheet
- Qualifying rounds must be played in the presence of another Club Member who will attest to your score.
- ➤ Sign in on Qualifier Sheet prior to playing, play your round, when done, write QUALIFIER in BIG letters on your ATTESTED scorecard, and put your scorecard in the Box near the Showers
- Qualifying will end approximately one week prior to the event. The players who qualified will be contacted.
- Members who qualify and agree to represent the Club at matches against other Clubs will be given a Sheridan Park Tournament Team shirt to wear while representing our Club at the event and the shirt is theirs to keep. Each member can only get at most one shirt but may qualify to play in multiple events.

### SHERIDAN PARK GOLF CLUB - HOLE-IN-ONE CLUB

As most of you know, the Club runs an optional Hole-in-One Club whereby members contribute \$10 one time for the year, to go towards a pool paid out at year's end to Members who have made "qualifying" Hole-in-One at Sheridan.

There's been some confusion on whether a Hole-in-One made from the Forward/Gold tees qualifies for a share of the pool and the answer is <u>yes</u> it does, just like a Hole-in-One from the Blue Tees does. Please note that once you start playing a round from a set of tees, you need to play that set of tees for the entire round. So, if you're playing the White Tees or the Blue Tees - you can't move to the Gold tees on the Par 3's (or any other holes) to get a little closer.

As of right now, 121 of our 133 members paid \$10 to get in the Hole-in-One Club, so the Pool is \$1,210. It's never too late to get it - if any of the 12 of you who aren't in, want in, please reply to this email. Last year, there were two members who had qualifying Hole-in-One's and split a pool of about \$1,100. If you had the only one in a season, you'd get the whole pot.

**Here's the Rules:** These are also on our website (LINK) Or use the new Hole-in-One icon on the homepage to get there

- 1) You gotta be in it to win it: A portion of the pool can only be claimed by members who paid the \$10 entry fee prior to their having the Hole-in-One.
- 2) <u>At Sheridan Only:</u> A Hole-in-One made at Sheridan between the time the course opens in The Spring and the <u>Club's Fall Party</u> counts, but note that Holes-in-One by Sheridan Club members at courses other than Sheridan <u>do not</u> count.

\*\*\*Note that a Hole-in-One made from the Forward/Gold Tees <u>does</u> qualify, but only if the entire round is played from the Gold tees. If you're playing White or Blue tees, you cannot play from the Gold Tees on the Par 3s.

However, a Hole-in-One made on Hole 11 from the Forward/Gold tees when the Gold tees are improperly placed just on the other side of the creek from the hole (next to the Ladies tees) does not qualify. The Gold Tees are never supposed to be next to the Red on that hole but it has happened by accident. Allowing a Hole-In-One in this case would give Members playing the Forward (Gold) tees a dramatically unfair advantage over Members playing from the White tees.

- 3) <u>Attested by a Member:</u> You must be playing with an <u>active member</u> of Sheridan Park Golf Club who attests to your Hole-in-One and signs your scorecard.
- 4) All 18 Holes Your Hole-in-One must be made within a complete 18 hole round.

### USGA - Repairing Ball Marks: Things Every Golfer Should Know

#### **SEE THIS LINK**

The proper technique for ball mark repair is easy and fast. Insert the ball mark repair tool behind the ball mark and gently pull the top of the tool toward the center. Continue working around the ball mark, pulling the surrounding turf in toward the center of the indentation. Avoid using a lifting or twisting motion because this can damage turf roots. Once you have finished pulling turf in toward the center, gently tamp the area down with your putter to create a smooth, firm surface.

## 2. Unrepaired ball marks cause lasting problems Failing to repair a ball mark may seem like a

minor oversight, but there are lasting consequences. Unrepaired ball marks can take weeks to heal.

### <u>5. Almost any pointed tool can be used to successfully repair a ball mark.</u>

Single-pronged and fork-shaped tools. Almost any pointed tool, including a golf tee, can be used to effectively repair a ball mark.

#### **ADOPT A HOLE**

Some club members have taken it upon themselves to "Adopt a Hole". We appreciate their work and hope that more members will follow Glen Gast's lead. If you don't want to, officially, adopt a hole, we encourage all members to do "a little extra". Extras would include: Fixing your own divots and some others; Fixing your own ball marks and fixing a few others; Pick up trash; Pick up broken tees in the tee boxes and put in trash. I know it doesn't sound like much, but it seems to have made a difference this year. These is generally less trash around, the tee boxes seem to have less broken tees, and the greens have less ball marks. This can only help our position when discussing the course with the town.

#### USGA - Tips & Suggestions for Improving Pace of Play

Playing at a better pace is not about hurrying up or rushing around the course. It is simply about being more efficient with your valuable time, as well as everyone else's. Here are some recognized tips for improving pace of play:

<u>Minimize your time on the tee:</u> On the tee it is usually acceptable for players to "hit when ready."

Plan your shot before you get to your ball: Once you are off the tee, think ahead. Determine your yardage and make your club selection before it is your turn to play. Very often, you can do this while others are playing, without disruption. If you take your glove off between shots, have it back on before it is your turn to play. Even a small step like this saves time.

**Keep your pre-shot routine short:** Pick your line of play once and trust yourself. Try to take no more than one practice swing, then set up to the ball and play your shot. Most importantly, be ready to hit when it is your turn. Be efficient after your shot too. Start moving toward your next shot promptly.

<u>Aim to play in 20 seconds</u>: From club selection to pre-shot routine to execution, strive to hit your shot in 20 seconds when it is your turn to play. Help keep play moving at a brisk pace.

#### Rules permit players to exchange yardage info without penalty

When sharing a cart, use a buddy system: Don't wait in the cart while your cartmate hits and then drive to your ball. Get out and walk to your ball with a few clubs. Be ready to play when it is your turn and then let your cartmate pick you up. Or drive to your ball after you drop your cartmate off and then pick him or her up after you hit.

Be helpful to others in your group: Follow the flight of all tee shots, not just your own. Once in the fairway, help others look for their ball if you already know the location of yours. Volunteer to fill in a divot or rake a bunker for another player if needed. Be ready to attend the flagstick for others.

**KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU:** Your correct position on the course is immediately behind the group in front of you, not immediately in front of the group behind you. Arrive at your next shot just before the group in front leaves the area in front of you. If you are consistently not able to keep up and a gap opens in front of you, invite the group behind you to play through, irrespective of the number of players in the group.

Be efficient on the putting green: Mark your ball and lift and clean it when you arrive at the putting green so you will be ready to replace it when it is your turn to play. You can usually line up your putt while others are putting, without disturbing them. Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green closest to the next tee and leave the green promptly after holing out. Wait until the next tee to record your score.

Remember that picking up your ball is permitted by the USGA Handicap System: In Non-Tournament Play, the maximum hole score for posting purposes is a net double bogey, equal to double bogey + any handicap strokes you receive based on your Course Handicap.
